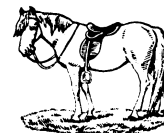

APPLICATION FOR DUPLICATE PASSPORT

The issue of duplicate passports is not undertaken lightly by the Society. Their issue is governed by Article 29 of EU Commission Implementing Regulation (EU) 2015/262. **This states that a duplicate can only be issued to an equine with a microchip.** The Council will consider the request for duplicate registration papers at its regular monthly meeting, and reserves the right to issue a passport for an equine of unknown breeding as the replacement. The Society will mark the replacement with the word 'Duplicate' and will complete Part II of Section II in accordance with EU 2015/262. Duplicate passports will only be issued to the currently recorded owner of the pony.

Please submit the following:

1. Completed ID chart:
 - (a) For a pony born post-2009, a vet must verify the microchip number, complete the ID chart and sign the form, or
 - (b) For a pony born before 2009 a vet must scan the pony to check for the presence of a microchip. If one is found, the number should be written in, the ID chart completed and the vet must sign the form. If no microchip is found, one must be implanted, the barcode sticker attached to the form, the ID chart completed, and the vet must sign the form.
2. Completed application form including statement and declaration of loss.
3. Photographs clearly showing all white leg markings and any white head markings
4. The fee of £60 (non-Society members) or £30 (members). Cheques payable to NFPB&CS. You may also pay by PayPal/credit card via the website.

Society Data Protection Statement

Under the terms of the Data Protection Act the Society has a responsibility to inform data subjects (pony owners) about the intention to collect data (which includes personal information relating to a pony owner's name and address) and how that data will be used. Information supplied in connection with your application and other horse passport based information about horse and owner is held in order for the Society to carry out its mandatory requirements as a passport issuing organisation. From time to time the Society is required to make such information available to Defra in order that Defra may carry out its responsibilities regarding the implementation of the horse passport legislation. All data as required by Defra will be uploaded to the Central Equine Database. The Society will also publish the data in the New Forest Pony Stud Book. The Society may also respond to requests from the Verderers of the New Forest in connection with the administration of their Higher Level Stewardship Scheme.
