CLOSING DATE FOR ENTRIES – 1 AUGUST 2019

Entries may be handed in at the Society stand at the New Forest Show, in the centrally located Heart of the Forest area.

SPONSORSHIP

GENERAL REMINDERS

- HOYS entries MUST be made on the HOYS entry form. This is a HOYS requirement. If you have never entered a HOYS class before, you will have to register on their database on the HOYS website, and get your ID numbers.
- Please make sure that you have done all your transfers of ownership and transfers to the Gelding Register, so that entries as catalogued are correct.
- Foals these must be either registered prior to entry, or the entry must be accompanied by a Birth Notification Form – the front page of the registration form. This is so their breeding can be checked and they are entered on the database which makes cataloguing them so much easier.

EQUINE INFLUENZA OUTBREAK – FLU VACCINATION POLICY

The Council of the Society strongly recommends that all ponies are vaccinated in line with BEF/BEVA recommendations. The Council reserves the right to bring in further measures depending on the circumstances prevailing at the time of the show, and in consultation with the Honorary Veterinary Surgeons.

SCHEDULE CHANGES

The schedule has had a major overhaul with re-ordering and re-numbering of classes, so please read carefully and note the new class numbers.

- ***NEW*** Expanded Open section on Saturday now includes a Walk and Trot class.
- ***NEW*** In-Hand classes in the open section on Saturday riding pony/horse in-hand; hunter type in-hand; competition/sports pony on the triangle.
- ***NEW*** Child Handler and Young Handler classes in the open section on Saturday.
- ***NEW*** Minimus jumping 1'3"
- ***NEW*** 3 classes of WHP Training Stakes which are also open to part-breds (maximum height 153 cm).
- ***NEW*** All dressage/CT classes open to part-breds except where otherwise stated.
- ***NEW*** Combined Training Prelim 1 and 2'3" jumping.
- ***NEW*** Pick Your Own Test class (Prelim 1 or Novice 28), in which entries can also be made on the day although they may be limited.

THE GYMKHANA WILL AGAIN TAKE PLACE ON SATURDAY AFTERNOON.

JUMPING CLASSES

In order to maintain the viability of the jumping classes, they are now open to any horse/pony (except where specified)

SPORTS PONY IN-HAND

This popular class continues. It will follow the NPS Competition/Sports Pony format. Details will be published on the website. It is running on both Saturday and Monday.

NPS QUALIFIERS

There is a good range of classes that are qualifying rounds for the NPS Summer championship show in 2020. You do not have to be a NPS member to take part in these classes. They include Training Stakes WHP, Novice WHP, Open WHP, Open Ridden, Junior Ridden, Part-Bred In-Hand and Ridden, most of the in-hand classes, Ridden and In-Hand Silver Medal Rosette Championships.

WELFARE CODE OF PRACTICE

The member bodies of the Showing Council have adopted a Code of Practice for the Welfare of Horses and Ponies at Shows and Events.

The document has been produced to provide advice and support to members, competitors, show organisers, stewards, judges, volunteer assistants and spectators. The full Code of Practice can be downloaded from the NPS website Education and Welfare section www.nationalponysociety.com/codeofpractice

DECLARATIONS

- Open WHP Declarations competitors must declare their height section and intention to jump with the Collecting Ring Steward before the last pony has jumped in the exceeding 143 cm novice WHP.
- Dressage Declarations must be made at least 30 minutes before the start of the class.

RETURN OF CUPS – BY 1 AUGUST 2019

Cups must be returned clean and undamaged to Pauline Black, The Radio House, Pilley Street, Pilley, Lymington, Hants SO41 5Q

You may bring your cups to the Society stand at the New Forest Show in the Heart of the Forest section.

HAT STANDARDS

The same rule as in the NPS 2019 Rule Book is adopted:

Correctly secured Skull Caps/Riding Hats that meet one of the following current Safety Standards/specifications MUST be worn by all Riders of all ages. All PAS 015; VG1; (BS)EN1384 2017; ASTM F1163 04a onwards; SNELL E2001; SNELL E2016; AS/NZS 3838 2003 onwards.

The most recent updates to the list are the addition of SNELL E2016 and EN1384 (2017); the newest version of the SNELL Standard could have begun to appear in 2017 and is accepted to the list; the newest version of the EN1384 Standard will begin to appear during 2018 and is also accepted to the list.

MEASURING

Please bring your **show number** and passport to the measuring stand, as this speeds things up.
