Rules

1. Cash only for entries on the day. Please bring correct change.
2. Large SAE for return of numbers. Please make sure correct postage is on the envelope (large stamp with barcode) Failure may result in numbers not being sent on time.
3. No substitution entries are allowed.
4. Classes will not be held. Any clashes of classes are not the shows responsibility.
5. Entries are accepted on the understanding that exhibitors have read the rules and agree to abide by the various society rules and the rules of the show.
6. All stallions and Colts two years old and over must have a current stallion licence. Stallions must wear a stallion disc.
7. Any animal not sufficiently under control shall be removed immediately without question at the request of a judge, steward or official.
8. Any person wishing to lodge a complaint at any reference to any person or exhibit shall do so in writing, whilst the class is in the ring, and at the same time deposit £50 to the show Secretary. If on investigation by members of the committee the protest is not sustained, the deposit shall be forfeited to the funds of the show.
9. The judges decision is final.
10. The Northern New Forest Pony Supporters Group committee or assistants take no responsibility of accountability for any loss, injury or damage to any person, animal, vehicle or property in connection with or arising from this show.

11. It is the exhibitors responsibility to have their animal correctly insured.
12. The show will not pay any vets fees for treatment obtained at the show.
13. No spurs in any classes.
14. Exhibitors are requested to study the rules for the qualifiers they are competing for.
15. Public Liability Insurance, which is strongly recommended, is the responsibility of the exhibitor.
16. Handlers and riders of stallions and Colts must have attained their 14th birthday in the current year.
17. Correct armbands must be worn to be awarded special rosettes/qualifications.
18. Competitors do not have to be a member of the NPS or the Northern New Forest Pony Supporters Group to compete.
19. Ponies must have a green New Forest Breed Society passport to compete.
20. In part bred classes, animals must have a red New Forest Breed Society passport to compete.
21. Passports must be on the showground with the animal.
22. The committee reserve the right to divide, amalgamate or cancel classes depending on the number of entries received.
23. Horseboxes, vehicles towing trailers and any other motor vehicle must park where directed. Failure to comply with this request will lead to you being asked to leave the Showground immediately and all entries forfeited. Please do not muck your horsebox out onto the showground.

These classes will be run under NPS Breed Show Rules.–Qualifying rounds for most NPS competitions are open to ponies owned by NPS members and non-members and at breed shows ponies can qualify for finals even if their owners are not members. Owners of qualified ponies must become adult Qualifying or Life members to enter the final of the competition at the NPS Summer Championship Show at Malvern from 6th – 8th August 2024.

The highest placed pony, in each class will qualify for the final. Qualification may pass down to third place if the first and second ponies are already qualified.

Class 1 New Forest Yearling

Young stock championship

Sp.Ch.1 First and second prize winners from classes 1-3 are eligible for the Youngstock championship. Rosette and Perpetual Trophy to Champion. Rosette to Reserve. Special Rosette: Best of Breed/New Forest Champion. Champion and Reserve go through to the New Forest Pony In Hand Championship.

Class 4 New Forest, 4 years old or over, mares.

Class 5 New Forest, 4 years old and over geldings.

Class 6 New Forest, 4 years old and over stallions.

Class 7 Small New Forest Pony, not exceeding 133cm. Any age.

Class 8 Forest Bred, (Registered New Forest Ponies that are sired and born on the open New Forest are termed as being Forest bred). Any age.

Class 9 Veteran New Forest, 15 years and over.

Class 10 Northern New Forest Pony Supporters Group Members In Hand,

Open to ponies of any age, entries must be paid up to members of the NNFPSG prior to the Show Day.

Special rosettes to the highest placed Forest Bred pony, best New Forest Pony not exceeding 138cm and highest placed NNFPSG Member in each class.

Classes 1-9 are qualifiers for the NPS/Absorbine M & M In Hand National Championship NPS/Mole Valley Farmers M&M Home Produced In Hand.

New Forest In Hand Championship

Sp. Ch. 2 New Forest In Hand Championship 1st & 2nd prize winners from classes 4-10 are eligible.

Rosette and Perpetual Trophy to Champion. Rosette to Reserve. Special Rosette: Best of Breed/New Forest Champion. Champion and Reserve go through to the Supreme New Forest Pony Championship. The New Forest In Hand champion qualifies for the NPS/Blackertor & Sharptor Studs M&M In Hand Silver Medal Rosette Championship, but the pony's owner must be or become an NPS member before the Final.

Class 18: Open Lead Rein New Forest

The NPS/Showing Classics Leading Rein National Championship Qualifier. Open to registered mares and geldings, 4 years old and over not exceeding 122cm. Rider not to have attained their 9th birthday in the current year. Ponies will not be stripped. Ponies must be shown in a snaffle bit. Handles on saddles are permitted.

Class 19: Open First Ridden New Forest

The NPS/Partridge & Parr First Ridden M&M Championship Qualifier. Open to registered mares and geldings, 4 years old and over not exceeding 128cms. Riders are not to have attained their 12th birthday by 1st January in the current year. Ponies must not be cantered except in their individual show. Ponies will not be stripped. Ponies may not be Ridden side saddle and can be shown in any suitable bridle.

Class 20: Junior Ridden.

The NPS/Cooper Family Junior M&M Championship Qualifier. Open to registered mares and geldings, 4 years old and over. Riders are not to have attained their 18th birthday by 1st January in the current year.

Class 21: Part-bred ridden

The NPS/Andrews Family Part Ridden Championship Qualifier. Open to ponies registered in the part bred section of the studbook.

Class 22: Novice New Forest Ridden

This is a qualifier for the NPS/Picton Stud M & M Novice Ridden National Championship. Eligibility for this class is as stated in the NPS Rule Book. Ponies must be shown in a snaffle bit. Special rosettes to the highest placed Junior on a New Forest Pony, 17 years and under, highest placed Forest Bred Pony, best New Forest pony not exceeding 138cm and highest placed NNFPSG Member.

Class 23: Open New Forest Ridden.

Open New Forest Ridden. This is a qualifier for the NPS/Ringside Stud M & M Open Ridden National Championship. Eligibility for this class is as stated in the NPS Rule Book. Special rosettes to the highest placed junior on a New Forest Pony, 17 years and under, highest placed Forest Bred Pony, best New Forest Pony not exceeding 138cm and highest placed NNFPSG Member. Bisterne Dee Light Trophy to the winner kindly offered by Natalie and Lauren Povey.

Class 24: Forest Bred Ridden

Open to any Forest Bred Pony (Registered New Forest Ponies that are sired and born on the open New Forest are termed as being New Forest Bred) four years old and over. Any suitable bridle.

Class 25: Veteran New Forest Ridden Pony.

Open to registered New Forest Ponies fifteen years old and over. Any suitable bridle.

Class 26: Northern New Forest Pony Supporters Group Members Ridden

Entries must be paid up members of the NNFPSG prior to show day. This is a qualifier for the NPS Derby House Amateur Ridden National Championship.

Ridden New Forest Championship

Sp. Ch. 3, 1st & 2nd prize winners from classes 18 to 26 are eligible. Rosette and Perpetual Trophy to

Champion. Rosette to Reserve. Champion and Reserve go through to the Supreme New Forest Pony Championship. Special Rosette: Best of Breed/New Forest Champion. The New Forest Ridden champion qualifies for the NPS/Nipna Dales Pony Stud M & M Ridden Silver Medal Rosette Championship but the pony's owner must be or become an NPS member before the Final.

Forest Bred Championship

Sp. Ch. 4, Forest Bred Championship. Winners of the Forest Bred Rosette from each class eligible to come forward. Rosette and Perpetual Trophy to the Champion, Rosette to Reserve. Special Rosette: Best of Breed/New Forest Champion. Champion & Reserve to go through to the Supreme New Forest Pony Championship.

Under 138cms Championship

Sp. Ch. 5, Under 138cms Championship. Winners of under 138cms rosettes from each class eligible to come forward. Rosette and Perpetual Trophy to the Champion, Rosette to Reserve. Special Rosette: Best of Breed/New Forest Champion. Champion and reserve go through to the Supreme New Forest Pony Championship.

Supreme New Forest Pony Championship

Sp. Ch. 7, The In hand, Ridden and Working Hunter New Forest Champions and Reserves to come forward for the Supreme New Forest Pony Championship. The Fijal Maestro Perpetual Tankard, Sash and Rosette to the Champion and Sash & Rosette to the Reserve. Rosette to the First Reserve champion. Special Rosette: Best of Breed/New Forest Champion.

Class 27 – New Forest Novice Working Hunter kindly sponsored by Mydroilyn Stud

Qualifier for the NPS Novice working hunter pony national championship.

Class 27A - Ponies not exceeding 122 cm.

Fences minimum height 45cm, maximum height 60cm, maximum spread 45cm.

Class 27B - Ponies exceeding 122 cm but not exceeding 133.

Fences minimum 55 cm, maximum height 65 cm, maximum spread 55cms.

Class 27C - Ponies exceeding 133 but not exceeding 143.

Fences minimum height 65 cm, maximum height 75 cm, maximum spread 65cms.

Class 27D – Ponies exceeding 143cm.

Fences minimum height 75cms, maximum height 85cms, maximum spread 75cms.

Open to registered purebred New Forest stallions, mares and geldings, four years old or over.

Rosettes to the highest placed junior, 17 years and under in class 24. Special rosettes to the highest placed Forest Bred pony, best New Forest Pony not exceeding 138cm and highest placed NNFPSG Member in each class.

Class 28 – New Forest Intermediate Working Hunter.

Qualifier for the NPS/AREA 5 M&M Intermediate Working Hunter Pony National Championship (MM-IWHP)

Class 28A – Ponies not exceeding 122cms

Class 28B – Ponies exceeding 122cms but not exceeding 133cms

Class 28C – Ponies exceeding 133cms but not exceeding 143cms

Class 28D – Ponies exceeding 143cms but not exceeding 148cms

Open to registered pure bred New Forest stallions, mares and geldings, five years old or over. Ponies never to have qualified for the NPS M&M Working Hunter Pony (Horse of the Year Show/RIHS) finals before 1st January in the current year

Rosettes to the highest placed junior, 17 years and under in class 25. Special rosettes to the highest placed Forest Bred pony, best New Forest Pony not exceeding 138cm and highest placed NNFPSG Member in each class.

Class 29 – New Forest Open Working Hunter.

Qualifier for The NPS/TOPSPEC M&M Working Hunter Pony National Championship (MM-WHP)

Class 29A – Ponies not exceeding 122cms

Class 29B – Ponies exceeding 122cms but not exceeding 133cms

Class 29C – Ponies exceeding 133cms but not exceeding 143cms

Class 29D – Ponies exceeding 143cms but not exceeding 148cms

Open to registered purebred M&M stallions, mares and geldings, five years old or over

Rosettes to the highest placed junior, 17 years and under in class 26. Special rosettes to the highest placed Forest Bred pony, best New Forest Pony not exceeding 138cm and highest placed NNFPSG Member in each class.

New Forest Working Hunter Pony Championship.

This Championship will be held in the WHP Ring on conclusion of the WHP Classes.

Sp. Ch. 6, New Forest Working Hunter Pony Championship. First and Second prize winners from each of the New Forest Working Hunter classes to come forward. Rosette and Perpetual Trophy to Champion, Rosette to Reserve. Special Rosette: Best of Breed/New Forest Champion.
