## COMMON RIGHTS ARE AT THE HEART OF THE WORKING OF THE NEW FOREST

The rights are attached to land and although there are different types of right, the most common is the right of 'pasture'. This allows commoners to 'turn out' cattle to graze the open Forest eating the undergrowth. Without this grazing the Forest would look quite different so commoning is vital to keep the Forest the way it is.
