Should a registered or eligible New Forest mare hold one of these passports her progeny will be deemed ineligible for registration.**

All applications must be correctly completed, signed and accompanied by the original identification chart overleaf which has been verified by a Veterinary Surgeon.

Any prefix or suffix within the name of the equine should only be used by the breeder and must have been registered with the Central Prefix Register.
