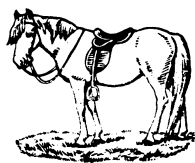

NFPB&CS Annual Breed Show **Cattle Classes 2025**

- Entries can be made using our online entry system, or on a separate Cattle entry form sent to the office
- Entry fees: Members £5.00 Non-members £10.00
- Judge: Mr Peter Bailey
- Provisional judging date for all cattle to be judged is **21 August 2025** on holdings within the vicinity of the New Forest National Park, or on the open Forest at the owner's risk and provided that cattle can be found at the appointed time.
- Ear tag numbers MUST be given on the entry form and passports must be available for the Judge's inspection.
- No substitute entries will be permitted.
- Cattle in Classes C1 and C2 must be tagged with a Verderers Ear tag and known to the Agisters to have LIVED continuously (day and night) on the Forest or added areas for four out of the last twelve months.
- Special rosette for the best Young Commoner from classes 1 - 2 and 7

CLASS C1:

BEEF COW or HEIFER in milk or in calf to have run on the forest - HARRIS CUP

CLASS C2:

BEEF STEER OR HEIFER not over 36 months on the day of the show, to have run the forest - CASTLETOP TROPHY

CLASS C3:

BEEF STEER OR HEIFER born on or after 01 August 2024 - MEYRICK CUP

CLASS C4:

BEEF COW OR HEIFER in milk or in calf - MR & MRS B WATTS CUP

CLASS C5:

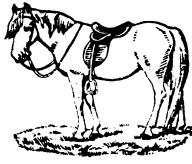
BEST ANIMAL sired by a British Native Breed - THE BRIDLE CUP

CLASS C6:

BEEF STEER OR HEIFER not over 36 months on the day of the show - R D PRETTY CUP

CLASS C7: COMMONERS BEEF HERD – THE BEECHWOOD MATTHEW GERRELLI MEMORIAL CUP

- Open to practising commoners in the year of the breed show
- The herd judged to consist of a minimum of three animals of any breed or age, but at least one to be entered in class C1 or C2.
- Entries to be judged at the same time as C1 or C2
- Special rosette to the highest placed Young Commoner

CATTLE CHAMPIONSHIP: open to the first prize winners from classes C1 and C2 only – THE FRED WINTER CUP
