Northern Counties Ponies Association Pony of The Year Show

The Showing Register Amateur of The Year

NPS Qualifying Rounds: These classes are judged under the Rules of the NPS. Ponies must be registered in the main body of their respective M&M Stud Book.

Qualifying rounds for most NPS competitions are open to ponies owned by NPS members and non-members but only ponies owned by adult NPS Qualifying or Life members are eligible to qualify for the final of the competition at the NPS Summer Championship Show at Malvern from 4th - 6th August 2026.

The highest placed pony, if owned by an NPS member, in each class will qualify for the final.

Qualification may pass down to third place if the first and second ponies are already qualified.

NPS/WTJ Insurance Brokers Ltd Home Produced Ridden Championship - Riders of Home Produced ponies (see definition in the NPS Rules Book) if owned by NPS members, are then eligible to qualify for the final at the NPS Summer Championship Show. The Owner's Membership cards MUST be produced in the ring when requested or the qualification will be forfeit.

Equifest Qualifiers - *The two highest placed exhibits not already qualified will qualify for the relevant Equifest Championship class to be held at Arena UK, Grantham, Lincolnshire on the 5th – 8th August 2026.*

EQUIFEST OPEN MOUNTAIN & MOORLAND IN HAND - Open to In Hand Mountain & Moorland ponies registered with the pure bred New Forest breed society stallion, mare, colt, filly or gelding, any age.

EQUIFEST OPEN RIDDEN MOUNTAIN & MOORLAND - Open to Mountain & Moorland ponies registered with their respective Pure Bred New Forest Breed society. Stallion, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over. Rider any age.

EQUIFEST OPEN MOUNTAIN & MOORLAND LEAD REIN - Open to Mountain & Moorland ponies, registered with their respective Pure Bred Societies New Forest Breed society. Mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 128cms. Riders not to have attained their 9th birthday before 1st January in the current year. To be led by an attendant and shown in a Snaffle Bridle, the lead rein to be attached to the noseband only.

EQUIFEST MOUNTAIN & MOORLAND FIRST RIDDEN - Open to Mountain & Moorland ponies, registered with their respective Pure Bred New Forest Breed society. Mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 128cms. Riders not to have attained their 12th birthday before 1st January in the current year. To be shown in any suitable bridle.

Equifest JUNIOR RIDDEN MOUNTAIN AND MOORLAND - Mares and geldings, 4 years old & over, registered in the respective pure bred Stud books of the New Forest Breed society. Riders of Large Breeds not to have attained their 18th birthday before 1st January in the current year.

Northern Counties Ponies Association Pony of the Year Show -

This show is a Qualifier for the NCPA Pony of the Year Show on the 13th September 2026. First and second prize winners in appropriate classes will qualify.

The Showing Register Amateur of the Year - The two highest placed amateur exhibits in classes 14, 15 and 20 not already qualified will qualify for the relevant **TSR** Amateur of the Year final class to be held at Stoneleigh Park,

Warwickshire on 28th and 29th November 2026. EXHIBITS DO NOT NEED TO BE MEMBERS TO QUALIFY - TSR MEMBERSHIP WILL BE REQUIRED FOR THEM TO COMPETE IN THE FINAL.

Rules

1. Cash only for entries on the day. Please bring correct change.
2. No substitution entries are allowed.
3. Numbers to be collected on the day from the entries desk.
4. Classes will not be held. Any clashes of classes are not the shows responsibility.
5. Entries are accepted on the understanding that exhibitors have read the Rules of the show.
6. All stallions and colts, two years old and over, must have a current stallion licence. Stallions must wear a stallion disc.
7. Any animal not sufficiently under control shall be removed immediately without question at the request of the judge, steward or official.
8. Any person wishing to lodge a complaint at any reference to any person or exhibit shall do so in writing, whilst the class in the ring, and at the same time deposit £50 to the show Secretary. If on investigation by members of the committee the protest is not sustained, the deposit shall be forfeited to the funds of the show.
9. The judges decision is final.
10. The Northern New Forest Pony Supporters Group committee or assistants take no responsibility for the loss, injury or damage to any person, animal, vehicle or property in connection with or arising from this show.
11. It is the exhibitors responsibility to have their animal and themselves correctly insured.
12. The show will not pay any vets fees for treatment obtained at the show.
13. No spurs in any classes.
14. Exhibitors are requested to study the rules for the qualifiers they are competing for.
15. Public liability insurance, which is strongly recommended, is the responsibility of the exhibitor.

16. Handlers and riders of stallions and colts must have attained their 14th birthday in the current year.
17. Correct armbands must be worn to be awarded special rosettes/qualifications.
18. Competitors do not have to be a member of the NPS of the Northern New Forest Pony Supporters Group to compete.
19. Ponies must have a green New Forest Breed Society passport to compete.
20. In part bred classes, animals must have a maroon New Forest Breed Society passport to compete.
21. Passports must be on the showground with the animal and be produced if required.
22. The committee reserve the right to divide, amalgamate or cancel classes depending on the entries received.
23. Horseboxes, vehicles towing trailers and any other vehicle must park where directed. Failure to comply with this request will lead to you being asked to leave the showground immediately and all entries forfeited. Please do not muck out your horsebox/trailer onto the showground and put all rubbish in the bins provided.

Class 2 2 & 3 year old filly or gelding.

Class 3 2 & 3 year old colt.

Youngstock championship - First and second prize winners from classes 1-3 are eligible for the Youngstock championship. Champion and reserve are eligible for the in-hand championship.

Class 4 New Forest, 4 years old or over, mares.

Class 5 New Forest, 4 years old and over geldings.

Class 6 New Forest, 4 years old and over stallions.

Class 7 Small New Forest Pony, not exceeding 128cm. Any age.

Class 8 Junior Handler under 18

Class 9 Forest Bred, (Registered New Forest Ponies that are sired and born on the open New Forest are termed as being Forest bred). Any age.

Class 10 Veteran New Forest, 15 years and over.

Class 11 Northern New Forest Pony Supporters Group Members In Hand,

Open to ponies of any age, entries must be paid up to members of the NNFPSG prior to the Show Day.

Special rosettes to the highest placed Forest Bred pony, best New Forest Pony not exceeding 138cm and highest placed NNFPSG Member in each class.

Classes 1-10 are qualifiers for the NPS/Absorbine M & M In Hand National Championship and the NPS/Mole Valley Farmers M&M Home Produced In Hand.

New Forest In Hand Championship

Sp. Ch. 1 New Forest In Hand Championship 1st & 2nd prize winners from classes 4-11 are eligible.

Rosette and Perpetual Trophy to Champion. Rosette to Reserve. Special Rosette: Best of Breed/New Forest Champion. Champion and Reserve go through to the Supreme New Forest Pony Championship. The New Forest In Hand champion qualifies for the NPS/Blackertor and Sharptor M&M In Hand Silver Medal Rosette Championship, but the pony's owner must be or become an NPS member before the Final.

Class 12: Part bred New Forest in hand 1,2,3

Class 13: Part-bred New Forest in-hand 4 and over

Class 12-13 are qualifiers for the NPS/Faulconbridge Part Bred M&M in hand national championship.

LUNCH BREAK – Classes will recommence not before 12pm.

Ridden classes will be in the outdoor arena. Competitors MUST enter via the lower gate and NOT past the gazebos and commentary van.

Class 14: Novice Lead Rein New Forest

The NPS/The King's Head Novice Leading Rein National Championship Qualifier. Open to registered mares and geldings, 4 years old and over not exceeding 122cm. Rider not to have attained their 9th birthday in the current year. Ponies will not be stripped. Ponies must be shown in a snaffle bit. Ponies never to have won a first prize of £10 or more in leading rein classes of qualified for the NPS/Showing Classics M&M Open leading rein finalists the 1st Jan in the current year. Qualifier for **The Showing Register LEAD REIN MOUNTAIN AND MOORLAND RIDDEN AMATEUR OF THE YEAR.**

Class 15: Novice First Ridden New Forest

The NPS/Bryndefaid Stud Novice M&M Championship Qualifier. Open to registered mares and geldings, 4 years old and over not exceeding 128cms. Riders must have attained their 3rd birthday but not to have attained their 12th birthday by 1st January in the current year. Ponies never to have won a first prize of £10 or more in first ridden classes of qualified for the NPS/Partridge & Part M&M Open First Ridden finalists before 1st Jan in the current year. Qualifier for **The Showing Register FIRST RIDDEN MOUNTAIN AND MOORLAND RIDDEN AMATEUR OF THE YEAR.**

Class 16: Junior Ridden.

The NPS Junior M&M Championship Qualifier. Open to registered mares and geldings, 4 years old and over. Riders not to have attained their 18th birthday by 1st January in the current year. Also a qualifier for the NPS/Fiona Cork Saddles Young Rider championship.

Class 17: Part Bred New Forest Ridden.

The NPS/Faulconbridge Part Bred Ridden Championship Qualifier. Open to ponies registered in the part bred section of the New Forest studbook.

Class 18: Novice New Forest Ridden

This is a qualifier for the NPS/Picton Stud M & M Novice Ridden National Championship. Eligibility for this class is as stated in the NPS Rule Book. Ponies must be shown in a snaffle bit. Special rosettes to the highest placed Junior on a New Forest Pony, 17 years and under, highest placed Forest Bred Pony, best New Forest pony not exceeding 138cm and highest placed NNFPSPG Member. Also a qualifier for the NPS/Fiona Cork Saddles Young Rider championship.

Class 19: Intermediate New Forest Ridden.

This is a qualifier for the NPS/Peasedown Stud & Jess Talbot Intermediate Ridden National Final. Open to pure bred registered stallions, mares and geldings. Eligibility is as stated in the NPS rulebook. Also a qualifier for the NPS/Fiona Cork Saddles Young Rider championship.

Class 20: Open New Forest Ridden.

This is a qualifier for the NPS/Ringside Stud M & M Open Ridden National Championship. Eligibility for this class is as stated in the NPS Rule Book. Special rosettes to the highest placed junior on a New Forest Pony, 17 years and under, highest placed Forest Bred Pony, best New Forest Pony not exceeding 138cm and highest placed NNFPSPG Member. Bisterne Dee Light Trophy to the winner kindly offered by Natalie and Lauren Povey. Also a qualifier for the NPS/Fiona Cork Saddles Young Rider championship. Qualifier for **The Showing Register MOUNTAIN AND MOORLAND LARGE BREEDS RIDDEN AMATEUR OF THE YEAR**

Class 21: Forest Bred Ridden

Open to any Forest Bred Pony (Registered New Forest Ponies that are sired and born on the open New Forest are termed as being New Forest Bred) four years old and over. Any suitable bridle.

Class 22: Veteran New Forest Ridden Pony.

Open to registered New Forest Ponies fifteen years old and over. Any suitable bridle.

Class 23: Northern New Forest Pony Supporters Group Members Ridden

Entries must be paid up members of the NNFPSG prior to show day.

Ridden New Forest Championship

Sp. Ch. 2, 1st & 2nd prize winners from classes 14 – 23 are eligible. Rosette and Perpetual Trophy to Champion. Rosette to Reserve. Champion and Reserve go through to the Supreme New Forest Pony Championship. Special Rosette: Best of Breed/New Forest Champion. The New Forest Ridden champion qualifies for the NPS/Nipna Sales Pony Stud M & M Ridden Silver Medal Rosette Championship but the pony's owner must be or become an NPS member before the Final.

Forest Bred Championship

Sp. Ch. 3, Forest Bred Championship. Winners of the Forest Bred Rosette from each class eligible to come forward. Rosette and Perpetual Trophy to the Champion, Rosette to Reserve. Special Rosette: Best of Breed/New Forest Champion. Champion & Reserve to go through to the Supreme New Forest Pony Championship.

Under 138cms Championship

Sp. Ch. 4, Under 138cms Championship. Winners of under 138cms rosettes from each class eligible to come forward. Rosette and Perpetual Trophy to the Champion, Rosette to Reserve. Special Rosette: Best of Breed/New Forest Champion. Champion and reserve go through to the Supreme New Forest Pony Championship.

Supreme New Forest Pony Championship

Sp. Ch. 6, The In hand, Ridden and Working Hunter New Forest Champions and Reserves to come forward for the Supreme New Forest Pony Championship. The Fijal Maestro Perpetual Tankard, Sash and Rosette to the Champion and Sash & Rosette to the Reserve. Rosette to the First Reserve champion. Special Rosette: Best of Breed/New Forest Champion.
