### Equine influenza vaccinations

Equine Influenza vaccinations are a compulsory minimum requirement for ALL horses/ponies competing. Any horse/pony commencing a new primary course from 01/01/2024 must be vaccinated as follows: the first 2 vaccinations 21 – 60 days apart, a third booster between 120-180 days, and an annual booster vaccination within 365 days thereafter.

Any horse/pony that received the primary course prior to 1/1/24 are permitted to have an interval of up to 92 days between the first and second vaccination of the primary course and an interval of between 150-215 days for the first booster.

No horse should enter competitions within 7 days of an EI vaccination.

Foals under the age of six months being shown at foot with mares can enter the showground without being vaccinated themselves, subject to the mare complying with the above vaccination rules prior to foaling.

Foals should commence their primary Equine Influenza vaccination course at 6 months of age.

Horses/ponies may compete after receiving the second vaccination of the primary course, provided that at least 7 days have elapsed since the vaccination.

This Rule may be subject to change following guidance from the FEI/BEF/SC & ASAO.

### Measuring

The Measuring Stand will be open from 7.45 am – 11 am on Saturday & Monday.

Passports & your competitor number MUST be presented with the pony at the measuring stand. Rugs and boots/bandages must be removed before the pony gets to the stand.

Ponies to be measured using the NPS Youngstock heights recommended for 'on the day of the show': yearling – 128cm, 2-year-old – 131cm, 3-year-old – 132cm.

# THE NEW FOREST STALLION & PONY PERFORMANCE DAY

## Saturday 29 August 2026

### RING 1 - 10am

#### **STALLION RULES**

1. All colts/stallions must be registered in the Approved section of the New Forest Pony Stud book.
2. All colts/stallions two years and over must have a New Forest Pony stallion licence (VC number).
3. All riders/handlers of stallions must have attained their 14<sup>th</sup> birthday before 1<sup>st</sup> January 2026.

#### **IN HAND FOREST RUN STALLIONS**

THE CRANESMOOR CUP and a premium of £100, and a Reserve premium of £50, donated in memory of Miss P Mangin will be awarded to the stallion from Classes 1-2 who is judged to have sired the best foals eligible for registration on the Forest in the current year. Foals will be judged on the Forest after the closing date of entries. Late Entries will not have their foals judged. PREMIUMS: £150, Premiums will be awarded to stallions 2 years old and over (classes 1-2). Premiums will be paid in the year of award.

#### **CLASS 1 FOREST- RUN COLT/STALLION 4 YEARS & UNDER**

Ponies must be 4 years and under. Stallions aged 2 years and over that are (or are eligible to be) in the Verderers grazing from 2026 and are eligible and available to run the Forest in 2027 Manes and tails can be lightly trimmed.

#### **CLASS 2 FOREST- RUN STALLION 5 YEARS & OVER**

Ponies must be 5 years and over that are (or are eligible to be) in the Verderers grazing from 2026 and are eligible and available to run the Forest in 2027. Manes and tails can be lightly trimmed. Ponies aged 4 and over may be shod. Stallions in this class must be measured. This class will split on height, if sufficient entries forward.

#### **FOREST RUN STALLION CHAMPIONSHIP**

Prize: £20 to Champion

Open to 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> prize winners of Classes 1-2 and the C Tillyer Memorial Cup winner.

Champion and Reserve may compete for the Supreme and the Breeders Cup (if eligible) on Monday.

#### **CLASS 3 FUTURITY YEARLING COLT**

Colts selected at the spring inspection

#### **CLASS 4 NPS ABSORBINE M&M NEW FOREST IN HAND YEARLING COLT**

#### **CLASS 5 NPS ABSORBINE M&M NEW FOREST IN HAND COLT 2 & 3 YEAR OLD**

This class will be split if sufficient entries forward.

Front shoes permissible for 3-year-olds only.

#### **YOUNGSTOCK CHAMPIONSHIP**

Prize: £20 to Champion

Open to first and second prize winners from classes 3-5

The winner and reserve are eligible for the Youngstock championship on Monday.

#### **CLASS 6 NPS ABSORBINE M&M NEW FOREST IN HAND STALLION 4 YEARS & OVER**

This class will be split if sufficient entries forward.

#### **STALLION CHAMPIONSHIP**

Prize: £20 to Champion

Open to 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> prize winners from class 6 and the Stud Youngstock Champion and Reserve.

Champion and Reserve may compete for the Supreme and the Breeders cup (if eligible) on Monday.

#### **FOREST BRED IN HAND STALLION CHAMPIONSHIP**

Open to winners of Forest bred rosettes in classes 1-6.

The highest placed 1, 2 or 3 year old may compete for the Kingett Memorial Cup

Riders must not have attained their 18<sup>th</sup> birthday before 1 January in the current year.

#### **CLASS 16 FAMILY PONY.**

Open to registered pure bred, part bred, first cross & X register ponies. Mare or gelding capable of giving an adult an interesting ride yet quiet enough for the younger members of the family, to be ridden in a snaffle bridle by an adult or child.

#### **CLASS 17 LEADING REIN PONY.**

Open to registered pure bred, part bred, first cross & X register ponies. Mare or gelding not exceeding 133cm.

To be ridden in a snaffle bridle. Riders must have attained their 3<sup>rd</sup> birthday but not to have attained their 9<sup>th</sup> birthday on show day. Measuring required.

\*The 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> prize winners qualify for the Under 133cm Championship on Monday.

#### **CLASS 18 FIRST RIDDEN PONY.**

Open to registered pure bred, part bred, first cross & X register ponies. Mare or gelding not exceeding 133cm. To be ridden in a suitable bridle off the lead by a child of 12 years or under on show day. No cantering except in individual show. Measuring required.

\*The 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> prize winners qualify for the Under 133cm Championship on Monday.

#### **CLASS 21 RIDDEN FIRST CROSS, PART BRED OR X-REGISTER.**

Qualifying round for the NPS Faulconbridge Part Bred Ridden National Championship. Horse/pony to be registered in the part-bred section of the New Forest stud book. Riders any age, except stallions.

#### **CLASS 22 RIDDEN RIDING OR HUNTER TYPE PONY/HORSE.**

Open to registered pure bred, part bred, first cross & X register ponies. Ponies must be four years old and over.

#### **CLASS 23 RIDDEN COMPETITION/SPORTS PONY/HORSE.**

Open to registered pure bred, part bred, first cross & X register ponies. Ponies must be four years old and over.

## YOUNG JUDGES COMPETITION 2026

### The Brian Wilson Memorial Trophy Kindly Presented By Mrs A Wilson

We are pleased to offer the Young Judges Competition again this year. Training has been taking place through the season and will conclude with an in-house competition on the Saturday of this year's breed show. The competition involves an assessment of ponies in the ring, followed by an informal discussion with panel judges who will then allocate awards. The overall winner will have the opportunity to accompany the judge of the supreme into the ring on the Monday of the show.

### PROGENY CLASS

The Progeny Class has been extended to include Ridden and In Hand classes on Saturday and Monday. The entry is to be made up of three related ponies (by Sire or Dam) on green passports that have already been entered in the Breed sections on Saturday and/or Monday. A pony can only be entered once for a progeny group. This will not involve the ponies being judged together in the ring. The result will be determined by the combined placings of the entrants in their chosen classes (one class per pony which must be stated on entry form). Entry must be received before any of the classes you are entered in start.

Prizes: 1<sup>st</sup> £10 to each of the three ponies. Rosettes to 6<sup>th</sup> place  
£20 to top Sire £20 to top Dam - Prize giving at the AGM

### RING 1 – 9am

#### FOREST BRED & FOREST RUN STOCK

Classes 27-28 are limited to ponies sired and foaled on the open Forest and which remained on the Forest until 1 August of year of birth.

#### **CLASS 27 FOREST BRED 4 YEARS OR OVER, EXCEEDING 138CM**

For Yeld mares, geldings, or broodmares 4 years or over with own foal at foot (foals must be at least 3 weeks old at date of show and should be led). Yeld mares and geldings may be shod.

#### **CLASS 28 FOREST BRED 4 YEARS OR OVER, NOT EXCEEDING 138CM**

For Yeld mares or geldings, or broodmares 4 years or over with own foal at foot (foals must be at least 3 weeks old at date of show and should be led). Yeld mares and geldings may be shod.

Measuring required.

#### **CLASS 29 FOREST BRED YOUNGSTOCK 1,2 & 3 YEAR OLD**

Yearling colts, fillies, geldings - Limited to ponies sired and foaled on the open Forest and which remained on the Forest until 1 August of the year of birth.

Front shoes permissible for 3-year-olds.

#### **CLASS 30 FOREST RUN YOUNGSTOCK 1,2 & 3 YEAR OLD**

Yearling colts, fillies, geldings to have run the Forest from 1 June to 1 August in current year.

2 and 3 year old fillies and geldings to have run the Forest from 1 May to 1 August in the current year.

#### PONIES NOT EXCEEDING 133cm

#### **CLASS 31 YOUNGSTOCK NOT TO EXCEED 133CM AT MATURITY**

1, 2 or 3 year old filly or gelding not to exceed 133cm at maturity.

Ponies in this class are to be measured using the NPS Youngstock heights recommended for

'on the day of the show': yearling – 128cm, 2-year-old – 131cm, 3-year-old – 132cm. If the pony measures out it can go in the relevant yearling or 2/3year-old class. Front shoes permissible for 3-year-olds.

Winner may go forward to the Youngstock Championship.

#### **CLASS 32 ADULT PONIES NOT EXCEEDING 133CM**

4 & over, mare, with or without foal at foot, or gelding. Ponies may be shod. Measuring required.

The winner is eligible to go forward to the relevant mare or gelding championship.

To have run the Forest for seven months since the last breed show.

#### **CLASS 42 VETERAN BROODMARE**

14 years and over with own foal at foot.

#### **CLASS 43 NOVICE BROODMARE**

Rosette to the best broodmare not exc 133cm eligible for 133cm Championship. Measuring required.

#### **CLASS 44 OPEN BROODMARE**

### **SHOW RULES**

#### **NATIONAL PONY SOCIETY SUPREME PRODUCTS M&M RIDDEN PONY OF THE YEAR**

This competition is open to stallions, mares and geldings, four years old and over, to be registered in, and complying with the showing requirements of, the main body of their respective stud books. Riders and Owners must be members of their respective Breed Society, NPS, UK Ponies & Horses, The Showing Register or BSPS. Ponies must not exceed the height limits as stipulated by the relevant Breed Societies. Riders of stallions must have obtained their 12th Birthday (small breeds) or 14th birthday (large breeds) before 1st January in the current year. Exhibitors are required by DEFRA to carry with them Official Identity Documents for all horses/ponies when competing or travelling. Competitors are reminded that it is a DEFRA requirement that the Official Identity Documents must be in the name of the legal owner within 30 days of ownership. This must be registered with the breed society, relevant studbook or ID issuing agency, dependant on breed/type of animal. Spot checks may be carried out at qualifying shows and by breed societies. These classes will be run in accordance with the general rules as set out in the Horse of the Year Show rulebook, a copy of which can be downloaded from [www.hoys.co.uk](http://www.hoys.co.uk).

Riders must not compete in both the Mountain & Moorland Lead Rein/First Ridden Pony of the Year and the Mountain & Moorland Pony of the Year.

This is a Horse of the Year Show Qualifier, all data given upon entry of this class is provided to Grandstand Media Limited and stored on the Grandstand Entries System. For full policy details please visit [www.grandstandentries.com](http://www.grandstandentries.com).

Marks will be awarded in the following way:

Show, freedom of action 50 maximum - Breed type and conformation 50 maximum

In the case of equality, the pony with the highest show, freedom of action mark will be deemed the winner.

If there is still equality at this point, then the judges' decision will be final.

This class is a qualifying class for Horse of the Year Show, NEC, Birmingham, 7th - 11th October 2026. Qualification will not pass below 3rd Place. Qualification will be verified by the Horse of the Year Show office.

#### **NPS QUALIFYING ROUNDS BREED SHOW RULES**

These classes are judged under the Rules of the NPS 2026. Ponies must be registered in the main body of their respective Mountain & Moorland Stud Books. Part breeds are not eligible for Mountain & Moorland Classes. Qualifying rounds for most NPS competitions are open to ponies owned by NPS members and

non-members and at breed shows ponies can qualify for finals even if their owners are not members. Owners of qualified ponies must become adult Qualifying or Life members to enter the final of the competition at the NPS Summer Championship Show at Malvern in **August 2027**.

The highest placed pony, in each class will qualify for the final. Qualification may pass down to third place if the first and second ponies are already qualified.

NPS WTJ Insurance Brokers Ltd Home Produced Ridden Championship - Riders of Home Produced ponies (see definition in the NPS Rules Book) can wear a white arm band in classes where this is indicated.

These ponies are then eligible to qualify for the final at the NPS Summer Championship Show.

A Silver Medal Rosette is offered by the National Pony Society for the best registered pony in the M&M

In-Hand and Ridden Sections. To be judged under the Rules of the NPS. At breed shows Silver Medals may be won by non-members. The owner of the qualified pony must become an Adult Qualifying or Life member to enter the final.

If the Champion pony has previously qualified it is still entitled to the Silver Medal Rosette but the qualification card goes to the Reserve Champion pony. The Silver Medal Rosette and the qualification card can be awarded no lower than first Reserve (third). Foals are not eligible for Silver Medal Championships. Qualifiers are entitled to compete in the final of the Silver Medal Rosette Championship to be held at the NPS Summer Championship Show in August 2027.

### **THE PRICE FAMILY SUPREME IN HAND SEMI FINAL**

### **THE PRICE FAMILY SUPREME IN-HAND HORSE OR PONY OF THE YEAR SEMI FINAL**

The following class is a qualifier for Supreme In-Hand Semi-Final at National Pony Society Great British In-Hand Show 2026, which is a qualifier for Horse of the Year Show, NEC, 7<sup>th</sup>-11<sup>th</sup> October 2026.

The objective of the competition is to find the supreme light horse or pony in-hand champion of the year, irrespective of breed or type (excluding heavy horses).

The Champion horse or pony from the following classes will be eligible to compete in The Price Family Supreme In-Hand Semi Final, provided it has not already won a Price Family Supreme In-Hand qualifier in 2026.

• The highest placed eligible in-hand pony in the Supreme Championship line-up. (Drawn from Forest-run stallion championship, stud stallion championship, gelding championship if the champion is 1, 2 or 3 years old, mare championship, youngstock championship, Forest-bred championship provided that this is not a gelding of 4 years of over). If the Champion has already qualified for Horse of the Year Show 2026 or is ineligible, then the Reserve Champion may come forward to The NPS Great British In-Hand Show, provided it has not already qualified and is eligible. If both Champion and Reserve Champion have already qualified for Horse of the Year Show 2026 or are ineligible then the Semi-Final will not be represented at the NPS Great British In-Hand Show. Foal champions and geldings four years old and over are not eligible to compete or eligible to qualify for Horse of the Year Show. In the event of a horse/pony having been awarded more than one section Championship at this show, that horse/pony will represent both/all sections and the Semi Final qualification will not pass down to the Reserve Champion in the 2<sup>nd</sup> and any subsequent sections. All classes are open to Yearlings, 2-year-olds, 3-year-olds, Stallions, broodmares and barren mares only. Broodmares must be with foal at foot or a relevant certificate of pregnancy. Mares which have not yet foaled or that have lost their foals are eligible to enter with a relevant certificate of pregnancy for the following year. There will be no direct entry into Supreme In-Hand Championship Semi Final, all animals must be a section champion or reserve champion (as applicable). Data given upon entry of this class is provided to Grandstand Media Limited and stored on the Grandstand Entries System. For full policy details please visit [www.grandstandentries.com](http://www.grandstandentries.com).

### **MEASURING**

All ponies entered in a class with an upper height limit (eg 133cm, 138cm) must be measured on the showground before the class by the Society's official measurer whose decision is final, unless they produce a JMB Certificate or a veterinary measurement height certificate (allowing 1 cm for shoes), which should be presented with the pony to the Measuring Steward so that it can be ratified. JMB LHC or a Society Certificate for a pony measured at 7 years of age or over will be accepted as permanent and will not need measuring year on year. JMB is now paperless and online only, so competitors wishing to use a JMB measurement must bring a printout of their pony's JMB database entry. This does not apply to class 14, Horse of the Year Show M&M qualifier, where ponies will be required to be in possession of a current/valid JMB height certificate within 28 days of the notification of qualification from HOYS or by the closing date of HOYS entries, whichever is sooner. Ponies to be measured using the NPS Youngstock heights recommended for 'on the day of the show': yearling – 128cm, 2-year-old – 131cm, 3-year-old – 132cm.

### **GENERAL ADMINISTRATION AND INDEMNITY**

1. Entry fees can only be returned on the production of a valid veterinary certificate less £5 for admin fees.
2. If the show has to be cancelled for any reason, the Council reserves the right to retain up to 50% of any entry fee paid to cover pre-show expenses.
3. Neither the Society nor any of its Officers or Servants will be responsible for anything that may happen from any cause or circumstance whatsoever to any person attending, or any animal exhibited, at the show. It shall be a condition of entry that each Exhibitor/Owner shall hold the Society harmless and that they will indemnify the Society against any legal proceedings arising from any such cause or circumstance.
4. Exhibitors are advised to insure against appropriate risk not only as regards their own property but also against any third party claim.

### **CUPS AND TROPHIES**

1. All Cups and Trophies are perpetual and may not be won outright. Any exhibit in the same ownership that wins the same trophy three years in succession will be presented with a small memento.
2. Exhibitors are responsible for having cups engraved.
3. Winners of cups that are not returned will NOT be permitted to compete at the show in the following two years. This rule will be strictly adhered to, except in proven circumstances. All cups must be returned clean and undamaged. The Society bears no responsibility for any damage howsoever caused up to the point of return, and the exhibitor is responsible for any repair costs incurred.

## **HEALTH AND SAFETY RULES**

1. Every person on the show ground has a general legal duty under the Health & Safety at Work Act to look after themselves and others who may be affected by what they do. This means you.
2. No galloping or cantering around the show ground except in the ring or warm up area where appropriate.
3. No ponies to be left unattended while tied to boxes / lorries.
4. Correct specification hats conforming to the latest British Standard that are correctly fitted and fastened must be worn by all riders on the show ground.
5. Body protectors are highly recommended for all jumping classes.
6. Hard hats and gloves are recommended for all in-hand classes (particularly young-stock and stallions).
7. Handlers of ponies in the In Hand classes aged 14 and under must wear a correctly secured current British Standard skull cap or riding hat.
8. No visible jewellery to be worn. The judge will ask the competitor to remove items.
9. A fall of rider or a pony in any class will result in disqualification.
10. The rider must not remount in the ring.
11. Dogs MUST be kept on leads at ALL times.
12. Dogs MUST NOT be left unattended in cars; they may suffocate in hot weather.
13. It is recommended that owners should have third party liability insurance.
14. Owners should keep their own animals under control at all times.
15. The Council reserves the right to order off the show ground any animal that they consider to be out of control or dangerous.
